Shop Staff: That sounds wonderful. (a)

Customer: Actually, I have never been abroad. This will be my first time. I am a bit nervous about it, but also very excited. I want to visit lots of amazing places.

Shop Staff: What part of the world do you want to go to?

Customer: I am interested in going to America, but I think I may have the chance to do that as part of my job. There are some countries in Asia that I want to visit sometime, but I don't want to do that as part of this trip. South America looks very interesting, but I don't really know much about it. I think I want to use this trip to see Europe.

Shop Staff: Ah, yes, that sounds wonderful. (b)

Customer: I will have two months until I start my job. I want to work in a part-time job for around four weeks to get some money, so maybe two or three weeks.

Plastic waste is a big problem. Most people in Japan these days know this, but many people do not understand the real size of the problem. People in Japan like fresh food that is easy to buy, and convenience stores are very popular. People can also buy drinks easily from machines in the street that are everywhere. Because of this, ①日本は他の国よりも多くのプラスチックを使用する国である。Only the United States uses more.

Consider, for example, plastic bottles, which are called 'PET' bottles in Japan. They are so convenient that Japan now uses around twenty-three billion plastic bottles a year. That is one hundred and eighty-three bottles for every person in Japan, every year. There is recycling of plastic bottles in Japan, but around two and a half billion bottles are not recycled. They are burned, put in the ground, or end up in rivers or oceans.

②The damage caused by plastic waste in oceans is very serious. One problem is that large fish and sea birds, and sea animals such as sea turtles and dolphins, eat the plastic when it is in large pieces. It stays in their bodies and can kill them. In Kanagawa in 2018, a dead whale was found with its body full of plastic. A second problem is that, over time, plastic breaks up into 'microplastic.' Microplastic is many small pieces of plastic. This microplastic is eaten by fish and those fish are eaten by people. In this way, plastic also ends up in people's bodies.

Many people think, "We are taking action to solve this problem, aren't we?" Plastic bottles are recycled and shops have to stop using a lot of plastic. Since June 2000, in convenience stores and supermarkets, customers must pay money for plastic bags. Many people now carry their own shopping bag. From April 2022, use of other plastic items like spoons and forks, and hotel items like hairbrushes, was cut.

However, this action will not be enough to solve the problem. Some reports say that ③plastic waste in the oceans will increase by four times by 2050. Environment campaign groups want countries to take action to reduce plastic. They also want people to think harder when they buy things in shops. When buying food that uses plastic, we have a choice. People may have to give up some (A) things to help save the (B).
